IIn 1986, the Irvington Historical Society and the Irvington Hysterical Jogging Society (not a typo) collaborated to create the first map of Historic Irvington sites. The running man pictured here emerged from that project. Signs were posted at key turns and map numbers corresponded with thistoric structures. Very cleve!

"The original map featured three trails.... We were picky about distances and created a 1-mile, 2-mile, and a 3-mile trail. Parts of the trail overlap. Fitness, especially running and jogging, was very popular at that time, and the distances multiprediffunction, rememberd Anna Chase, one of the original Hysterical Joggens. That tradition continues with this updated version offering that same set of tirails. The geographic area and the types of sites have expanded, but the same great community is showcased.
